## WHY STOP THE SPRAY?

**GLYPHOSATE**  
is **TOXIC** 

The main ingredient in forest herbicides is **known** to be toxic to fish, amphibians, and invertebrates and thought to be carcinogenic to humans and wildlife.



The aspen and deciduous tree species eliminated by herbicide could act as a natural firebreak due to higher water content and lower resin if left alone.

Herbicide kills the vegetation which is vital food and forage for a range of wildlife from bees and other insects to birds, beaver and especially moose.

Studies show glyphosate may persist in soil for many years
